70 GUIDES TO WORKPLACE PROTOCOLS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO PREPARE LOCKDOWN ENDING

MINISTER OF LABOR MURIEL PENICAUD STATED

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USPA NEWS - Prime Minister French Edouard Philippe explained the next stages of easing the lockdown, in France in a press conference this Thursday, May 7. The Minister of Labor, Muriel Penicaud, meanwhile explained the easing of lockdown when it comes for the measures offered to the workers and entrepreneurs, and said that « There will be 70 guides to workplace recommendations, which serve out on Monday, May 11 » and instructions to adopt from the lockdown, which will take place from May 11, alongside Prime Minister Edouard Philippe. This containment, which started on March 17th, in response to the spread of COVID-19, will be lifted « gradually" and will be accompanied by recommendations to be cautious, especially the most vulnerable (Disabled, Elderly), and that M100 mask will be offered and distributed, from May 11th, added the Minister of Labor, Muriel Penicaud, whose full remarks, we publish as it follows. (Updated on May 10 at 9:35 pm) These figures do not take into account deaths from COVID-19, at home, or those of disabled people who died in specialized centers.

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70 GUIDES TO WORKPLACE PROTOCOLS WILL BE OFFERED, MINISTER OF LABOR MURIEL PENICAUD SAID

The health of wages and will never be an adjustment variable. Companies and associations, whatever their size, will define the distance, the wearing of masks, cleaning protocols and associations of employee representatives and will take into account the activity. Business and sector guides will be validated by ministries of work and health, There will be 70 guides Sunday and especially for hairdressing salons and food shops. In 24 hours we will support companies that had not planned these health measures, in the charters to organize telework. We will also consider, shift schedules, and at the workplace.
